However, due to lack of monitoring the program implementation is tardy. In many programs the guidelines are violated and resources are diverted.

By regularly conducting **AUDITING OF PROGRAMS, BUDGETARY ALLOCATIONS, THEIR IMPLEMENTATION & THE ACTUAL BENEFITS**, will pressurize the institutions to properly implement the programs.

Auditors can audit the programs at different levels: **VILLAGE, DISTRICT, STATES AND NATIONAL.**

Suggested activities by Auditors:

1. Auditing implementation of Union and State Governments Budgets - ALLOCATION - IMPLEMENTATION - RESULTS.
2. Auditing of Programs and Schemes RESEARCH - IRRIGATION PROJECTS - RURAL HEALTH - EDUCATION.
3. STUDY AND SUGGEST REMEDIAL MEASURES ON CONTROLLER AND AUDITOR GENERAL OF INDIA REPORTS.
4. MONITORING Parliament Standing Committee Reports.
